


#### Spring 2018 – Thetis Vale Consultation


> While this consultation showed strong preferences in this specific community, it was clear that due to class size and composition requirements as well as increased enrolment, that the process needed to be broader.



#### Phase Three – Tillicum/McKenzie Boundary


• The Tillicum catchment would be reduced through the creation of an expanded catchment for McKenzie and an adjusted catchment for Quadra.




