

Frequently Asked Questions - Lansdowne South Land Disposal Greater Victoria School District No. 61

1) Are aware of the Bowker Creek Blueprint?

Yes. The Board of Education passed a motion in 2018 that states "That the Board of Education endorse in principle the Bowker Creek Blueprint. That the Board will need to consider its commitment in principle, including the context under which the District committed in 2018 and how that has changed in the meantime, if anything, when it considers the decision (3 readings) on the blueprint by the Board."
